File new Initial Application for UC Benefits

- Should be eligible for date of April application forward
- 39 weeks available
- Will receive the \$600 weekly "bump" from April to July
- **Can apply for PUA to cover time period in March before eligible for UC**

I had zero (or very limited) wages in 2019



Apply for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) (available end of April)

- Retroactive benefits to when you lost your job
- Weekly benefit rate between \$195 and \$572
- 39 weeks available
- Will receive the \$600 weekly "bump" from April to July
